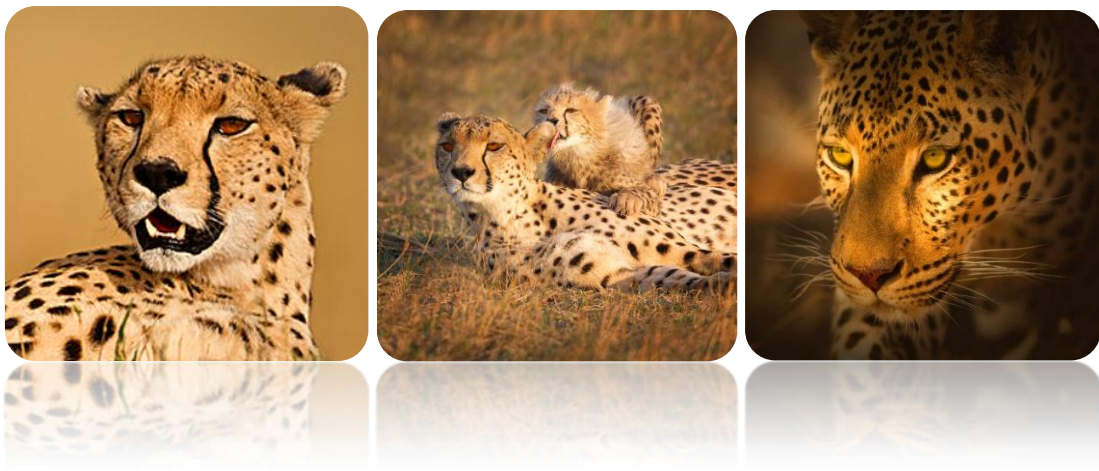


The Ultimate Big Cats Photo Safari - 2012



This “Ultimate Big Cat Photo Safari” offers you a 15-day predator photographic safari into the heart of Southern Africa’s very best private game reserves. You will stay in world-class lodges – spouses and partners of photographers are especially welcomed. The game reserves are renowned as probably the best places to experience view and photograph Africa’s big predators. Of course there will be a large variety of other wildlife to photograph too.

It would be a challenge to better the photographic opportunities for predators offered by this photo safari, anywhere in Africa; we have selected the best.

Photographers of all levels of experience are welcomed as you will be encouraged to ask questions. This is a photographic safari on which you can improve your knowledge and skills. It is not a game viewing safari; we just ask for your patience and enthusiasm.

Accommodation – world class.

In a nutshell, we have selected some of the best available, whilst endeavouring to retain reasonable affordability of the overall safari. You will be pampered and surprised at the level of luxury offered “in the bush”. To maximise the time for photography we have confined the number of lodges to three, staying in each long enough to get to appreciate what each has to offer. You will not be disappointed.

1. Sabi Sands Bush Lodge – 4 nights

For decades Bush Lodge has been Sabi Sabi's flagship lodge, famed for its warmth, vibrancy and legendary hospitality. A favourite amongst travellers in search of luxury accommodation, Bush Lodge is a luxurious safari escape set in the heart of the Sabi Sabi bushveld overlooking a waterhole and an African plain.

Bush Lodge's charm is evident from the outset. Here you will savour uncompromising high standards of service, efficiency and personalised attention.

Each of the spacious, air-conditioned thatched suites is beautifully appointed, featuring exquisite ethnic décor in keeping with the bushveld environment. The en-suite bathrooms feature al-fresco as well as glass-fronted indoor showers, affording wonderful views of the bushveld.

Large viewing decks are the ideal setting to relax while spotting game, bird watching, or cooling off in the filtered pools. Meals, including the wonderful dinners in the open air boma, are heralded by blasts on a kudu horn, a summoning to delicious food. This luxury safari lodge also features artistically designed open courtyards with spectacular wooden carvings by renowned South African sculptors, created from uprooted trees and wood salvaged from the surrounding bushveld.

2. Mashatu Tent Camp – 5 nights

The Mashatu Tent Camp is almost one with the environment – just blink and you might miss it! This is the leisure choice for the guest who seeks the ultimate one-on-one bush experience, or who prefers a more intimate environment with never more than 14 companions (and no children under 12 years of age).

The completely private comfortable tents are tucked under the branches of enormous trees, accessible via meandering pathways. The tents are themselves spacious and comfortable (enabling adults to stand upright). Each unit is mounted on a concrete platform, and has its own private outdoor en-suite facilities (including W.C and shower). Have you ever showered under the stars?

Instant camaraderie is a by-product of this characteristic camp. Meal-times are shared without pomp and ceremony, either in the open-air thatched gazebo, or in the boma

overlooking a floodlit and popular waterhole. A plunge pool provides a refreshing break.

You may also photograph or just watch from the hide, also overlooking the waterhole. The sturdy and shaded structure enables bush enthusiasts to sit quietly and to observe animal species going about their day. And the best part – the animals are completely unaware that they are not alone. It is humbling indeed to be an observer, standing where the world is perfect.

3. Mala Mala Main Camps – 4 nights

The soul of Mala Mala's Main Camp is evident, in the sepia photographs in the safari bar, reflecting the history of the area; in the massive Jackal berry tree, a silent witness in the boma from the beginning; in the faces of the staff, some who have worked here for over 30 years; in the floodplain beyond the camp which has witnessed the changes year on year; in the granite outcrops of Sithlawayise and Campbell Koppies which stand guard over this pristine wilderness area; in the Sand River which journeys through this sanctuary supporting the healthy eco system, and in the generations of wild animals which have found solace in their home territories on Mala Mala.

Every aspect of the Main Camp is designed to appreciate and enjoy the view of the surrounding wilds. Pathways wind their way along the perimeter of the camp to reveal individual ochre colored units tucked into the greenery which flanks the Sand River. Massive trees and rolling green

lawns are filled with birdsong, with the occasional antelope or elephant which seeks the succulence of greenery.

The camp is unfenced - an oasis in the middle of the bushveld. The luxury suites of Mala Mala are the ideal place to end our photo safari. You will not wish to leave Africa!

1. Iconic Images International Pty Ltd

Iconic Images International Pty Ltd (“Iconic Images”) is a company registered in Western Australia. Iconic Images in conjunction with C4 Images & Safaris, South Africa will be your guide during the land package segment of the photo safari.

Harvey World Travel East Perth, acting as the booking agent for this photo safari, can also assist you with flights to/from Africa &/or with any private extensions to the photo safari you may wish to arrange either before the photo safari commences or after it finishes.

2. Costs & Terms of Payment

The photo safari commences in Johannesburg on 13th September 2012 and finishes in Johannesburg on 27th September 2012.

The all-inclusive cost is **AUD\$14,550.00** per person, twin share. If specifically requested, a single supplement of AUD\$2,450.00 is applicable. *Also, please see information regarding currency exchange movements in Section 8, page 16, below.*

Terms of Payment are as follows:

- A non-refundable 25% deposit together with the signed Registration Form, no later than Friday, 17th February 2012. *Places will be allocated strictly on the basis of receipt of the completed Registration Form together with payment of the first deposit.*
- A second non-refundable payment of 25% no later than 30th April 2012.
- A final payment of the remaining 50% no later than 30th June 2012

3. What Is Included

- Pick up/drop off at Johannesburg Airport
- Transport for the entire photo safari
- Two persons per tent/room (i.e. double occupancy)
- All park entrance fees where applicable
- All meals commencing with dinner on 13th Sept and finishing with breakfast on 27th Sept 2012
- Continuous assistance with your wildlife photography by the three professional photographers/tour leaders
- The services of experienced local drivers/guides
- A maximum of four (4) photographers per vehicle when photographing
- Gratuities to drivers/local guides

- Tour leaders who understand the needs of photographers

4. What Is Not Included

- Alcoholic beverages
- Optional activities (e.g. balloon flight or fixed wing aircraft flights)
- Personal Travel/Medical insurance costs
- Travel visas and associated costs
- Airport taxes (if applicable)
- Other expenses of a personal nature
- International airfares from Australia to Johannesburg return
- Credit card surcharges (if applicable)

5. Cancellation Policy & Fees

Harvey World Travel East Perth must receive written notice of any cancellation by you at which time, the following cancellation fees will apply:

- If cancelled 90 days or more before departure a fee equal to 50% of the photo safari cost will be payable.
- If cancelled less than 90 days before departure, or in the case of a “no show” on the date of departure, a fee equal to 100% of the photo safari cost will be payable.
- Failure to pay by the due dates will be deemed to be a cancellation of the booking and all fees paid prior to the due date will be non-refundable.
- Bookings made within 60 days of the departure date must be paid in full on booking.

No refunds will be made for unused portions or services of the photo safari for any reason. The photo safari is sold as **a land package only**. Cancellation fees are not transferable.

For flight cancellations and any private pre and/or post photo safari arrangements, please refer to the booking agent, Harvey World Travel East Perth, or to your own booking agent, if used, for any specific conditions.

Credit card surcharges will apply if the fees are paid by credit card. Current surcharges are 2% for payments by Visa or MasterCard and 3.5% for other types of credit cards. Direct deposit facilities are available and details may be obtained from Harvey World Travel East Perth.

Iconic Images reserves the right to cancel this safari. In the event of this happening, all payments received for the land package will be refunded, but the participant shall have no further claim, of any nature whatsoever, against Iconic Images, or its agents, arising out of such cancellation. Any such refund will not include payments or cancellation charges for any bookings for private or additional services made in addition to the itinerary outlined above. Responsibility for such bookings lies solely with the participant.

6. Insurance Is Compulsory

Due to the relative remote destinations in this photo safari, participants are **required** to purchase emergency evacuation insurance coverage. To emphasize, emergency evacuation insurance is *MANDATORY* for this safari.

Harvey World Travel East Perth can assist you with information on the required insurance, should you wish.

Due to the non-refundability of deposits paid, as stated above, participants are strongly urged to purchase travel protection insurance at time of or prior to paying the first deposit.

If you pay for this photo safari using your credit card and you opt to use the general travel insurance associated with major credit cards, we urge you to check that this cover provides fully for emergency evacuation. Also, please ensure that all pre-existing medical conditions, if any, are made known to the insurance underwriter at the time of application for your insurance for this photo safari. These precautions will assist avoid any delays in the event that an emergency evacuation or other medical services are called upon, under your policy.

7. Health Considerations

This photo safari is designed to be within the capabilities of average people

in good health. Some of the time participants may be required to walk over uneven terrain or trails, stepping into an out of Land Cruiser type vehicles, occasionally hiking -- while carrying an assortment of sometimes heavy camera equipment. If you have concerns about your own capabilities and/or fitness as it relates to this trip, please enquire with Denis Glennon AO on 0418 923 103 or at denis@denisglennon.com before reserving a place.

By forwarding a signed Registration Form and paying the initial non-refundable 25% deposit, you warrant that, to the best of your knowledge, you do not have any physical or other disability that would create a risk for you or other trip participants. Iconic Images reserves the right to request a medical certificate from a participant at any time before departure or during the photo safari. The photo safari leader's judgment will provide the ultimate determination of an individual's ability to embark upon or to continue the photo safari. Once a booking has been accepted by Harvey World Travel East Perth and Iconic Images, medical circumstances will not be considered as exceptions to the cancellation policy. Iconic Images assumes no responsibility for medical care or for special dietary requirements. Due to the remote destinations of some parts of this photo safari, **participants are required to purchase emergency evacuation insurance coverage** (see Section 6 above, headed "Insurance is Compulsory"). If you sustain an injury or become ill on the photo safari, Iconic Images reserves the right to continue the photo safari for the benefit of other participants. Iconic Images and C4 Images & Safaris will make every effort to assist you while at the same time trying to minimize interruption to the photo safari.

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Iconic Images reserve the absolute discretion, in the event of behaviour detrimental to other persons, to decline any person's participation at any time during the photo safari and cancel that person's participation in the photo safari, in which case any refund will be on a recoverable cost basis only.

8. Responsibility

Iconic Images and/or its agents act only as agents for the participants in this photo safari, in regard to travel arrangements including, but not limited to, sightseeing, meals, lodging and transportation, whether by railroad, vehicle, motor coach, boat, ship or aircraft. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Iconic Images and/or its agents, disclaim liability for injury, damage, loss, or delay which may be occasioned by reason of a defect in any vehicle or for any other reason whatsoever, or through the acts or default of any company

or person engaged in conveying the participant or in carrying out the arrangements of the photo safari.

Iconic Images and/or its agents accepts no responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delay or other changes in air or other services, sickness, weather, strike, war, quarantine or other causes. All such losses or expenses will have to be borne by the participant, as the photo safari costs provide for arrangements only for the times and locations stated. Baggage, including photographic equipment is at the participant's risk entirely. All care has been taken to compile the information in this and the other documents pertaining to this photo safari but circumstances change, including but not limited to, airline schedule changes, airline fuel charges, tax increases and increases in operational costs are subject to change. Iconic Images and/or its agents cannot be held responsible for changes that occur and reserve the right to change the price up to the date of commencement of the photo safari. Changes in price may also include adjustments for adverse currency exchange fluctuations.

The right is reserved to (i) substitute hotels/lodges/tents/camps of similar category for those indicated and to make any changes in the itinerary or transport where deemed necessary or caused by changes in schedules or equipment substitution; (ii) cancel the safari prior to departure, in which case a refund of all payments received for the land package will be given. However, in such event Iconic Images and/or its agents will not be, responsible for any other trip preparation expenses such as penalized or non-refundable air tickets, visa fees and medical related expenses; (iii) substitute the photo safari leader(s) for the leader(s) originally specified, in which case the substitution is not a basis for participant cancellation or refund, or (iv) accept or refuse any person as a participant in the safari.

In the event that, at the sole discretion of Iconic Images, it is necessary or advisable for the photo safari to be cancelled due to such events as outbreak of conflict, government intervention, or withdrawal of access/traffic rights, or in the event of insufficient numbers being available, the refund of all monies paid, pro rata if applicable after commencement, shall constitute a full and final settlement by Iconic Images and their agents of any obligations to participants. The operation of the photo safari is at the sole discretion of Iconic Images, having in mind the welfare of all participants and the safe and prudent operation of the itinerary and program.

The photo safari price is based on having a minimum of ten participants and

on tariffs and the \$US/AUD\$ currency exchange rate in effect at 20th May 2011, and is subject to adjustment in the event this exchange rate changes adversely.

Participants will be informed of such an adjustment, if applicable, fifteen (15) days before making the final payment. Iconic Images is obligated to pay the costs of the photo safari in US dollars.

The Registration Form must be completed and signed by each participant at the time of paying the first deposit. Participation by any person will be declined in the absence of a completed and signed form. No modification to the Terms and Provisions of Registration, detailed on page #3 of the Registration Form, will be accepted.

9. Liability

Iconic Images does not accept any liability of whatever nature, whether in contract, tort or otherwise, for the acts, omissions or default, whether negligent or otherwise, of third party providers. Under circumstances where liability cannot for some reason be excluded, such liability is limited to the cost of the land package arrangements. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Iconic Images disclaims liability in contract, tort or otherwise for any injury, damage, loss (including consequential loss), delay, additional expense or inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by force majeure or any other event which is not preventable by reasonable diligence on Iconic Images International's part.

10. Specific Information about Packing Personal Effects and Camera Gear for this Photo Safari

As we will be flying between Australia, Johannesburg it is important that you read the following information carefully.

When in our vehicles we will not be confined to the usual low weight per person, experienced on planes. Ideally pack your camera gear as your hand luggage (i.e. your cameras, lenses, etc.) so that it can be carried with you onto the plane. This will ensure if one of your in-hold bags is delayed or lost at least you can commence photographing as soon as you arrive in South Africa. As we

will be passing through Johannesburg airport it is highly advisable to have your in-hold baggage shrink-wrapped at your Australian departure airport.

Please DO NOT travel with HARD suitcases; hold-all/duffle bags are better for packing in the vehicles.

Pack you camera gear in bags such as those manufactured by Lowepro, Think Tank etc.

Ensure you have your long lenses (>300mm) well packed in protective packs designed for such lenses.

Participants will be provided with a more comprehensive information kit prior to departure from Australia.
